ARTWORK GUIDELINES

- Project can be new or used recyclable materials: beverage containers, paper, metal, card board, wood, aluminum, or any items that can be discarded in the Blue recyclable trash container.
- Use of glue, tape and other non-recyclable fasteners will be allowed.
- Any art medium (sculpture, collage, etc.)

Entries due by 5 PM on Wednesday, April 25.

ART CONTEST INFORMATION AND RULES

- Contest is open to Cerritos residents of all ages and students attending schools in the ABC Unified School District. City of Cerritos employees or City contractors are not eligible to participate.
- One entry per artist.
- All entries must be original artwork.
- Artwork cannot be larger than 24 inches long x 36 inches high.
- Entries must be made of 100% recyclable materials. No paint, crayon, chalk or other forms of colorization allowed.
- Use of glue, tape and other non-recyclable fasteners will be allowed.
- Copy of entry form must be included with the artwork.
- Entries may include a written description of theme, message and recycled materials used.

- Entries must be submitted to the Cerritos Sports Complex by 5 PM on Wednesday, April 25.
- Entries must be picked up from the Cerritos Sports Complex by 5 PM on Monday, April 30. Any entries that are not picked up by that time will be discarded.
- Prizes: Each participant will be awarded a ribbon and a Certificate of Recognition. Awards will be announced and presented by the Cerritos City Council on Saturday, April 28 at 4:30 PM on the main stage at the Community Spring Festival.
- Winning entries will be displayed in the Cerritos Library and photographed for the City's website during the month of May.
